FEE:

Candidates (Except Female/SC/ST/Persons with Benchmark Disability Candidates who are exempted from payment of fee) are required to pay fee of Rs. 100/- (Rupees One Hundred only) either by remitting the money in any Branch of State Bank of India by cash or by using Net Banking facility of any bank or by using Visa/Master/ RuPay/Credit/Debit Card/UPI Payment.

How to Apply:

Candidates are required to apply online by using the website <https://upsconline.gov.in>. It is essential for the applicant to register himself/herself first at One Time Registration (OTR) (Registration) platform, available on the Commission's website, and then proceed for filling up the online application for the examination.

PRELIMINARY EXAMINATION:

The Examination shall comprise of two compulsory Papers of 200 marks each. Note: (i) Both the question papers will be of the objective type (multiple choice questions) and each will be of two hours duration. (ii) The General Studies Paper-II of the Civil Services (Preliminary) Examination will be a qualifying paper with minimum qualifying marks fixed at 33%. (iii) The question papers will be set both in Hindi and English

SSC

1. **Educational Qualification** – Candidates must hold a Bachelor’s degree from a recognized university or institution. Certain posts may require specialized subjects such as Statistics, Mathematics or Commerce.
2. **Nationality / Citizenship** – Applicants must be citizens of India or fulfill the nationality conditions prescribed by SSC including subjects of Nepal, Bhutan or Tibetan refugees who settled in India before 1st January 1962.
3. **Age Limit** – The SSC CGL age limit 2026 varies depending on the post generally ranging between 18 to 32 years. Age relaxations are provided for reserved categories as per government norms.
4. **Physical Standards** – For certain posts of SSC CGL such as Inspector or Sub-Inspector, candidates must meet the prescribed physical and medical fitness standards including parameters like height, chest measurement and eyesight.

SSC CGL Number Of Attempts

There is no set number of attempts. It is determined by the candidate's age and position. For example, if starting at 21 and ending at 30, an inspector in central excise has 9 attempts. Specific attempt limits will be updated here.

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Minimum Qualifying Marks for CUET

The minimum qualifying marks for CUET depend on the category of the student. Here is the simple breakdown:

- **General Category:** At least 50% marks in Class 12.
- **OBC/SC/ST/PwD Category:** At least 45% marks in Class 12.
